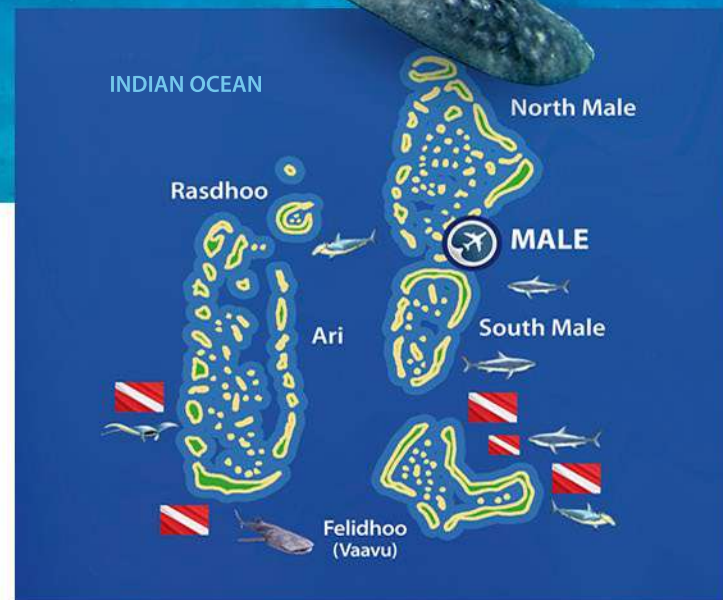
CENTRAL ATOLLS ROUTE

This is the best well-known route in the Maldives but at the same time it is the one that offers the best and most varied dives. We go on this route 10 months a year (except June) with weekly departures. Thanks to that, we know every detail, atoll, passage, thilas and where and when it is convenient to approach every dive zone.

It is a 7-night route including 6-dive days on board with embarkation and disembarkation at the Male Airport (18 dives with 2-night dives).

The itinerary goes by North Male, South Male, Felidhoo and Ari Atolls.

The aim is to find pelagic, grey sharks, white-tip sharks, black-tip sharks, and in some occasions, hammerheads and dolphins, eagle rays, schools of colorful fishes, morays, tuna fish, gild-head breams, groupers and turtles. Drifting dives in water passages and canals, thilas (submerged coral "seamounts"), cleaning stations where big mantas gather together to be deworn and the search of the whale shark (and if we are lucky will snorkel and even dive with the biggest fish). We will dive into a full-of-life wreck. Besides, there will be two of the most spectacular night dives in the world: one with mantas and the other with dozens of nurse sharks.



Desert islands and typical fishermen villages are also visited to discover and enjoy a bit more of the country and if the weather allows doing so we will even have BBQ lunch on a island.

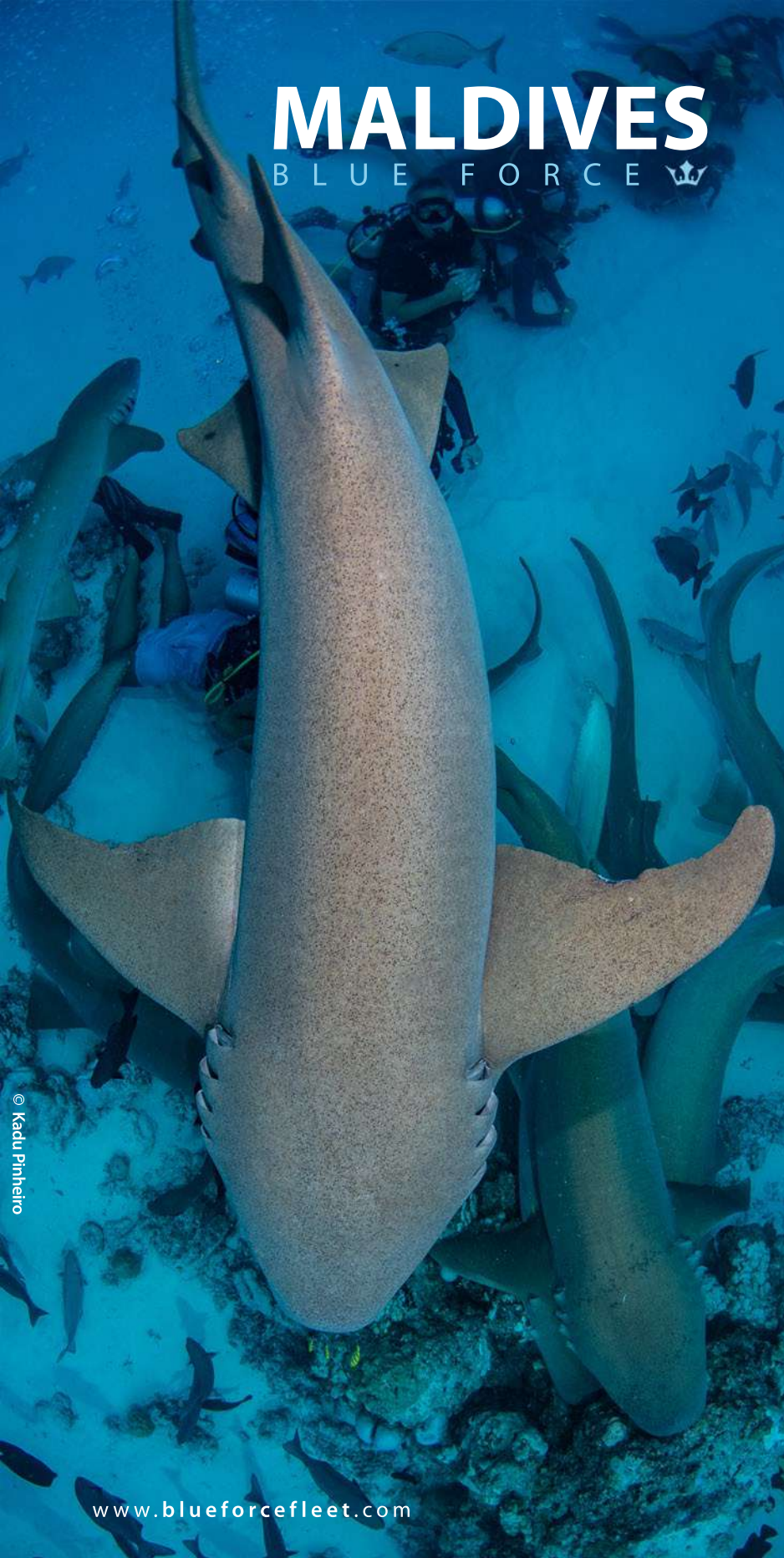
Although if you are looking to relax, you can enjoy the solarium and the jacuzzi on board, kayak, Paddle SUP...

CRUISE PROGRAM

Day 1 (Saturday): ARRIVAL TO MALE - EMBARK

Arrival at Male airport. One of our staff members will be waiting for you at Male Airport. You will then get onto our auxiliary boat Dhoni for the transfer to MALDIVES BLUE FORCE ONE or 3 for check in, briefing of the liveboard, diving and plan itinerary. Dinner onboard.

Day 2 to 7 (Sunday to Friday): CENTRAL ATOLLS ROUTE

The route will go through North Male, South Male, Felidhoo and Ari atolls. Daily dive program for certified divers including day dives, night dives and possibility of snorkel and dive with Whale sharks (total: 18 dives per week). For non-divers we will offer different activities such as snorkel, kayak, paddle SUP... If the weather and logistic allow, we will have a BBQ on a desert and will visit some populated island. On Friday afternoon we will anchorage next to Male. So, we will have the option to make a guided visit to Male.

Day 8 (Saturday): MALE AIRPORT

Disembark at Male Airport at 07.00 am. If the return flight leaves in the afternoon there is an day hotel option near the airport, and even free time to optionally visit Male until the time of the return flight.

RATE PER PERSON INCLUDES:

Transfers airport – yacht - airport •Stay in a double cabin sharing on MALDIVES BLUE FORCE ONE or MALDIVES BLUE FORCE 3 in full board basis. Water, tea and coffee. 18 dives including S80 tank, weights, guides and diving boat (Dhoni). Travel, diving and cancellation insurance (see covers in www.blueforcefleet.com).

RATE PER PERSON DOESN'T INCLUDE:

Flights to Male. Payments upon arrival onboard: Maldives taxes: \$185, Green tax: \$42 Service fee: \$130. Optional: NITROX. Internet access. Soft drinks and alcohol. Day hotel" optional in Hulhumale (direct payment). Diving equipment and S100 tank (it is possible to rent. It should be booked previously). Possible supplement by extraordinary increases of petrol or local taxes.

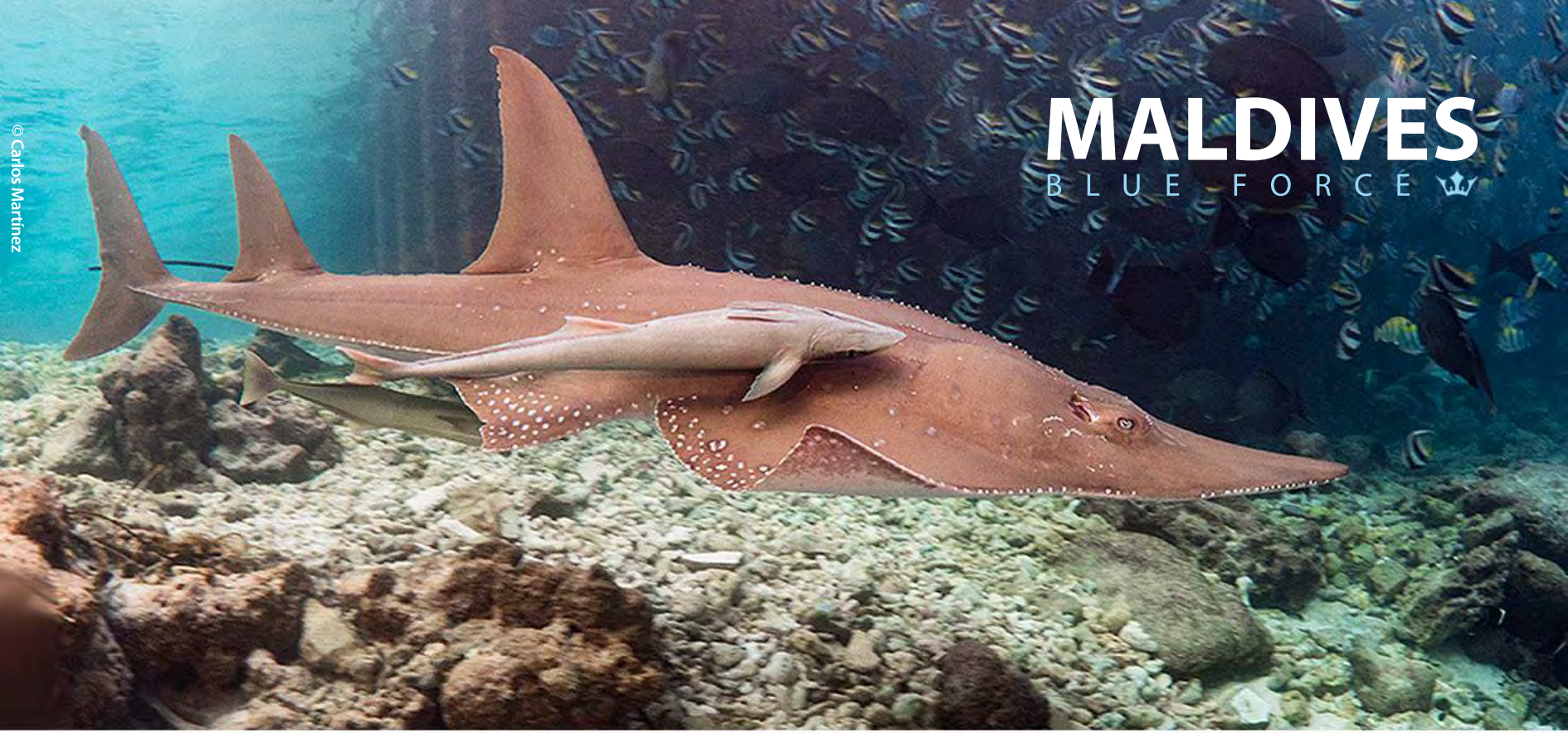

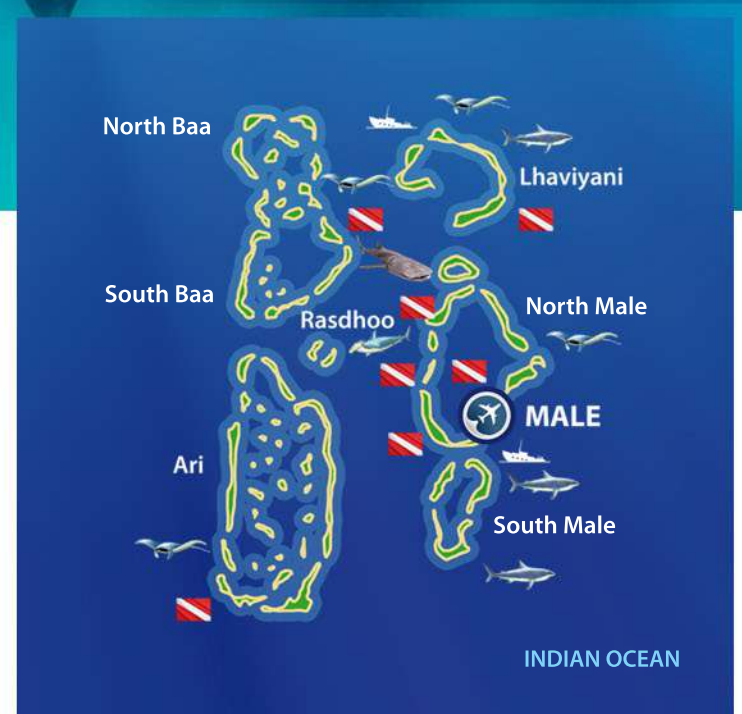

At the end of September is the best season to visit the North Atolls in Maldives. We recommend an interesting diving cruise called **MANTA EXPEDITION**. After a first diving day in North Male where we look for a Manta cleaning station, we will sail northbound to the Baa Atoll & Hanifaru Bay. 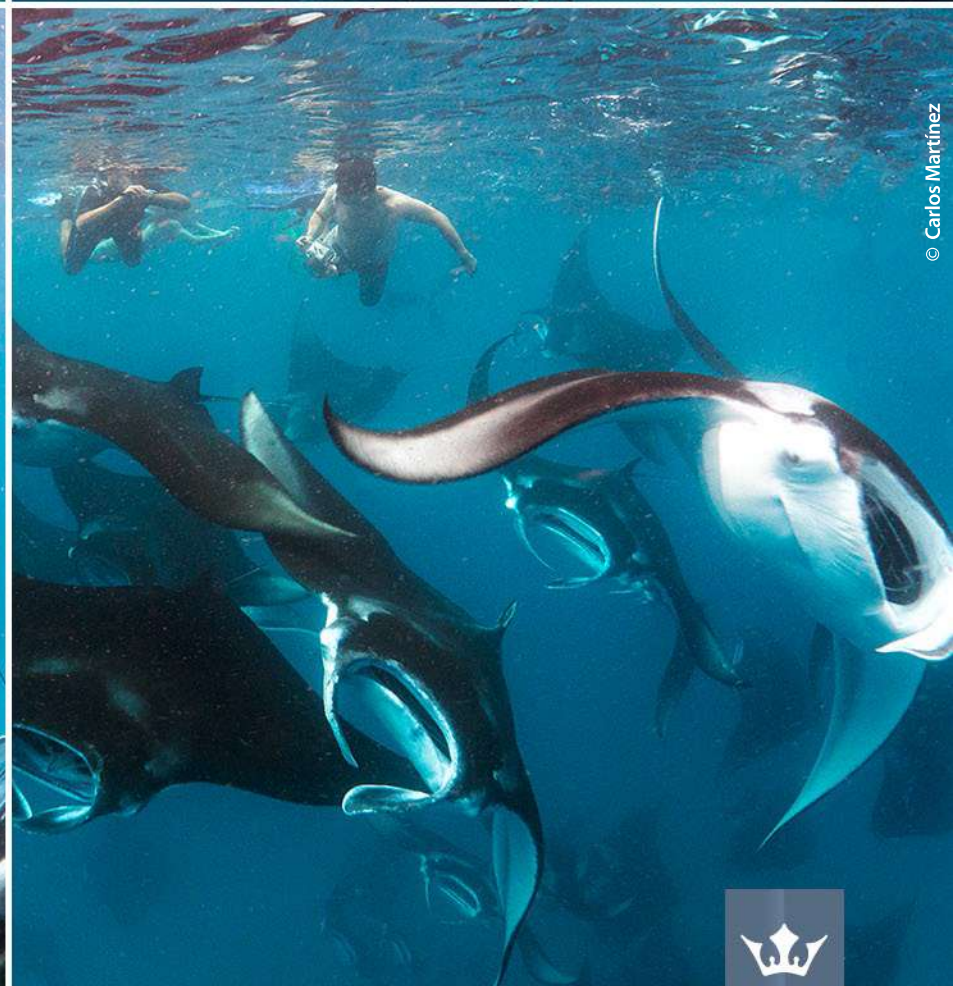

SOUTH HEMISPHERE ROUTE “Kooddoo – Kooddoo”

- **Itinerary:** Gaafu & Fuvahmulah.
- **Objectives:** Pelagics in Deep South channels such as Kooddoo, Vilingili, Marihaa and Nilandhoo, huge numbers of green turtles and grey reef sharks, schools of spotted Eagle Rays and even the elusive marlin. Thilas with spectacular coral gardens, channels (kandu) with sharks, pelagics and other possible oceanic encounters. Whale sharks at night and diving with mantas.

Most interesting spots on the route:

-  **GAAFU:** The second biggest atoll in the world is famous for the high shark concentration, especially the grey reef shark. But many surprises such as the great hammerhead, silver tip or tiger sharks may arise, as well as the whale shark in presence of plankton. The almost virgin coral areas are also remarkable. Nights among green turtles, parsnips or the presence of a fish only sighted in the South, the lime harlequin fish that lives in schools among corals.

Desert beaches and fishermen islands where you can see the Maldivian people who have been fishing and farming as a way of life far away from tourism.

-  **FUVAHMULAH:** If weather permits, as there is no protection reef, we will approach this unique island - about 5 km² - and will dive the reef near the great blue, where we can spot schools of jacks, mantas, lots of silver tip sharks, humphead wrasse and always the chance to spot “specials”, the elusive thresher sharks, tiger sharks, great hammerheads, marlins, humphead parrotfish ...

 **January 13rd - 23rd, 2024 (10 nights):** Boarding in Male and debarking in Gaafu (Kooddoo Airport).

 **January 23rd to February 3rd, 2024 (11 nights):** Boarding in Gaafu (Kooddoo Airport) and debarking in Male.

Itinerary: The Atolls of Fuvahmulah, Gaafu, Laamu, Thaa, Meemu, Vaavu and Ari.

Objectives for this route: Mantas on cleaning stations, mantas at night, nurse sharks in Vaavu, pelagic life and schools of sharks in the channels of Meemu, Laamu and Gaafu, whale sharks at night in Thaa, tiger sharks and silver tip sharks in Fuvahmulah.

Our team at MALDIVES BLUE FORCE 3 has planned the live aboard season in the Atolls of southern Maldives for the months in which the conditions are optimum for diving in this area of the country. In 2024 the boat will start its Southern Maldives season with two exceptional 10 and 11 nights liveaboards leaving from Male and ending in Fuvahmullah and vice versa. By extending the amount of days on board, this route permits us to dive, on the same trip, what can possibly be considered the "**BEST OF THE MALDIVES**".





This route is exceptional and for the most part, off of the normal path that most live aboards follow. Besides the extended amount of days on board from 7 to 10 or 11, with the obvious increment of dives we will be making, what is most amazing is the quality of the sites we will be allowed to reach. The amount of life we will be able to observe: large schools of jacks, schools of grey sharks, silky sharks, whale sharks at night sometimes in the day as well, mantas, tiger sharks, silver tip sharks, Marlins and even the occasional and elusive Oceanic Sun Fish (mola mola). As well as the quality and exuberance of the coral reefs around here, the thilas with their spectacular reefs and the nurse sharks from Alimatha, really make this route **the BEST OF THE MALDIVES**.

-  **VAAVU:** Without a doubt, the TOP dive sites on this atoll are Miyaru Kandu, a spectacular channel near the island of Alimathaa where we will be able to see many grey reef sharks and the Alimathaa Pier famous for the nurse shark dive, where you will be surrounded by dozens of these amazingly docile animals and will engage in an extremely unique experience.
-  **MEEMU:** This incredible atoll, is where we go to enjoy rich channels, which are teeming with life, such as the channel of Vanhuravelhi, breath taking dives like Muli Corner, where you never know what the ocean is going to surprise you with or the manta cleaning station at Kureli Manta point.
-  **THAA:** We will enjoy the colourful Dhifushi Kandu and look for the whale shark at night.
-  **GAAFU:** Undoubtedly known for its excellent channel dives. We can expect some adrenaline pumping dives in the most famous channels of Maldives for grey reef shark sightings. We might also get some surprise appearances by silver tip sharks or even an occasional whale shark if the plankton is abundant. Lets not forget to mention the pristine zones of almost untouched coral reefs, diving with the green turtles and large sting rays and visiting deserted beaches and small fishing villages, where we get a glimpse of the authentic Maldivian islands, far from tourism and living off fishing and agriculture as a way of life.

-  **LAAMU:** Fushi Kandu and Isdhoo Muli, where we can find schools of eagle rays, schools of jacks and will search for the rather shy Hump head parrotfish. Hitadhoo corner also offers its Manta cleaning station.
-  **FUVAHMULAH:** If weather permits, because there is no fringing reef to offer protection, we will visit this peculiar island, about 5km long, where we can dive off the reef into the big blue. There we might encounter large schools of jacks, mantas and sharks, Napoleon wrasse as well as possible "special encounters" like the elusive thresher shark, tiger shark, silver tip shark, marlin, oceanic sunfish... We will also try to dive on the island's south wall, one of the best conserved coral reefs of all of Maldives.
-  **ARI:** On this Atoll, anything is possible, whale shark encounters, manta cleaning stations...yet we are here for something different, we are here to enjoy one of the most exclusive dives in the Maldives, the night manta dive.
